The students learned how to properly fill out and use cheque and deposit slips. The bank staff explained the significance of each section on these forms, enhancing students' understanding of transactional accuracy.

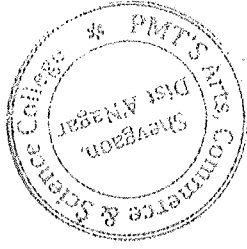
4. RTGS and NEFT Transactions:

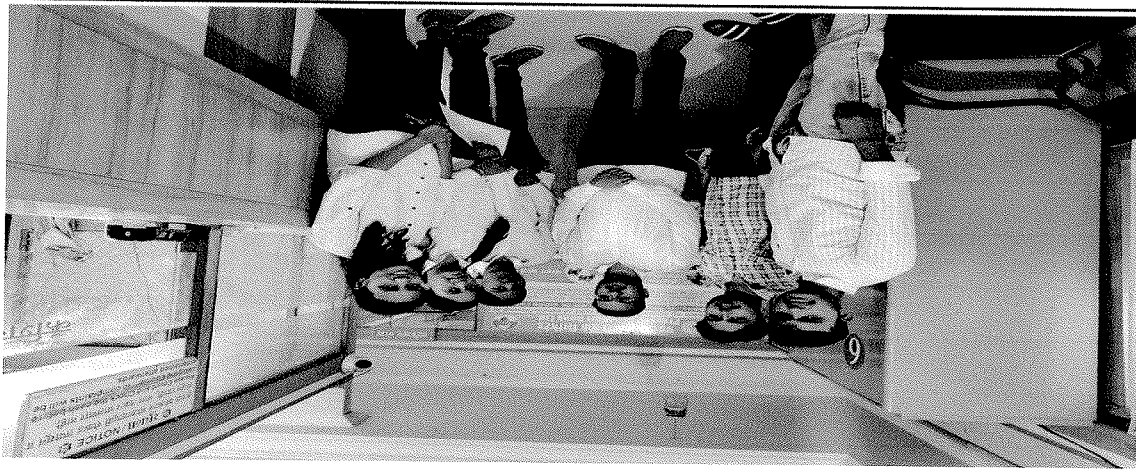
Conclusion:

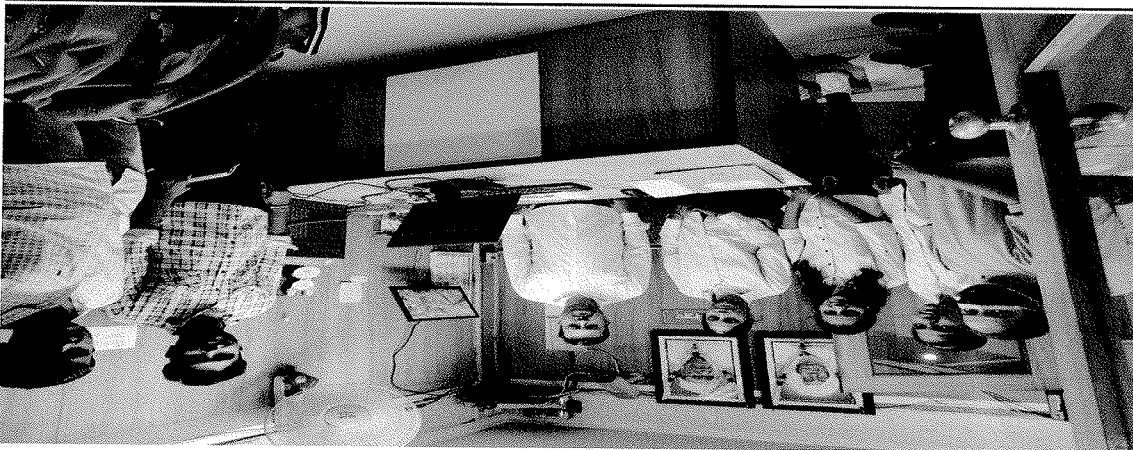
