
Respected Sir,

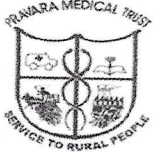

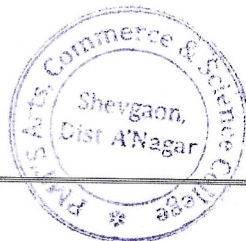

❖ **Introduction:**

❖ **Inauguration and Film Screening:**

The Literary Festival began on December 4<sup>th</sup>, 2021, with the inauguration ceremony. Mr. Sajed Patel, the Head of the English Department, took the stage to deliver the introductory speech. Mr. Patel welcomed the guests, participants, and students to the festival and outlined the various events scheduled over the next few days.
