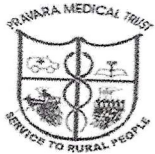

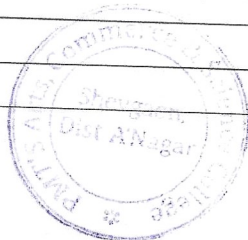

**Report**

❖ **Introduction:**
