





Objective:-To understand the operational work flow ad technology used in sugar manufacturing. To gain insights into the production of ethanol and its chemical processes. To explore the roles of different departments, including engineering, chemical, civil and accounting. To observe safety protocols, inventory management, and labour management in an industrial setting.

Overview :-

The industrial visit to the Shri Rudheshwar Sahkari Sakhar Karkhana Li. Adinathnagar aimed to provide students with practical insights into the sugar manufacturing process, ethanol production, engineering applications, and various aspects of operations management within a sugar factory.

Ethanol Department:

In the Ethanol Department, students learned about the conversion of molasses, a byproduct of sugar manufacturing, into ethanol. This process involves:

- Fermentation: where molasses is fermented to produce alcohol.
- **Distillation:** a purification process that separates ethanol from other impurities.
- Quality Control: the ethanol produced is tested for purity and concentration.

The following departments are visited, along with their contributions and relevance to the student's field of study.

Agronomy and Crop Management

In this department, Mr. Narayan Nibe gave valuable guidance on crop management students were introduced to the science behind crop cultivation, growth stages, and yield optimization. 





- Enclosed building capable of protecting the product from the weather and especially direct sunlight.
- Clean environment, free of dust/dirt.
- > Temperature between 5 and 30°C (some fertiliser types are sensitive to high temperatures)
- > Protect the fertiliser from moisture, which can cause lumps and dust, influencing spreading capabilities

- > Equipped with pallet racking to avoid the need for double stacking
- > Good stock management e.g. carried out on a First In, First Out basis

By interacting with experts from diverse fields, students gained insight into the chemical principles crop management, horticulture, and pest control. 


